



TOWN OF MOUNT GILEAD BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

The Mount Gilead Board of Commissioners met at 7:00 p.m. at Mt. Gilead Fire Department, 106 E. Allenton St., Mt. Gilead, NC for a regular monthly business meeting. Present were Mayor Chip Miller, Mayor Pro Temp Tim McAuley, Commissioners Vera Richardson, Paula Covington and Mitch Taylor, Town Manager Matt Christian, Town Clerk Amy Roberts, Public Works Director Daniel Medley and Police Chief Pat Preslar.

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Miller called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

ITEM I. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Vera Richardson made a motion to adopt the agenda. Tim McAuley seconded the motion. Agenda was adopted unanimously.

ITEM II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A. May 7, 2019 – Paula Covington made a motion to adopt the May 7, 2019 regular Meeting minutes. Tim McAuley seconded the motion. Minutes were adopted unanimously.

B. May 21, 2019 – Paula Covington made a motion to adopt the May 21, 2019 Budget Work Session Minutes. Vera Richardson seconded the motion. Minutes were approved unanimously.

ITEM III. PUBLIC COMMENT

Ms. Charlotte McAuley, 530 Parkertown Rd., Mt. Gilead, NC – Ms. McAuley expressed her concerns about the loud music in her neighborhood. She stated that there have been a lot of shootings lately and she is really concerned. She also wanted to state that she wishes the Town would fix the roads in Parkertown. The asphalt is washing away on the right side of the road coming down the hill in Parkertown.

A. Mayoral Proclamation Honoring Timothy McAuley, Sr. – Mayor Miller presented a proposed Proclamation honoring Timothy McAuley, Sr. for his many years of service and dedication to the citizens of Mt. Gilead. The Proclamation will be presented at the Friends in Focus Gala on June 20 at 6 p.m. at the James Garner Center in Troy. Mitch Taylor made a motion to adopt the Proclamation. B. New Police Officer Introduction– Chief Pat Preslar introduced new officer, Jake Shuping to the Board. Jake has been a reserve officer with the Town of Mount Gilead since 2016 and filled the position of Officer Jonathan Williams as a full time officer.

ITEM V. PUBLIC HEARING

A. Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Annual Budget Public Hearing
Vera Richardson made a motion to open the public hearing. Paula Covington seconded the motion. Public Hearing was opened.

Matt presented the final proposed draft of 2019-2020 Annual Budget pursuant to NCGS 159-17.

Vera Richardson made a motion to close the Public Hearing and return to open session. Mitch Taylor seconded the motion. Public Hearing was closed.

ITEM VI. NEW BUSINESS

A. Interlocal Agreement for Building Inspections

Matt presented a resolution from Montgomery County pursuant to NCGS 160A-461 to contract with the County to use the services of the County Inspections Department to the enforce the NC Building Code at no cost to the Town.



ITEM VII. STAFF REPORTS


Staff reports were presented by Police Chief Pat Preslar and Public Works Director Daniel Medley and are included in the agenda packet.
