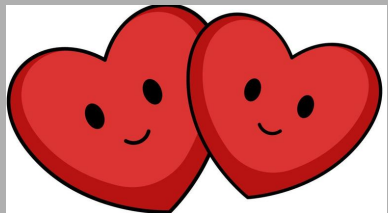

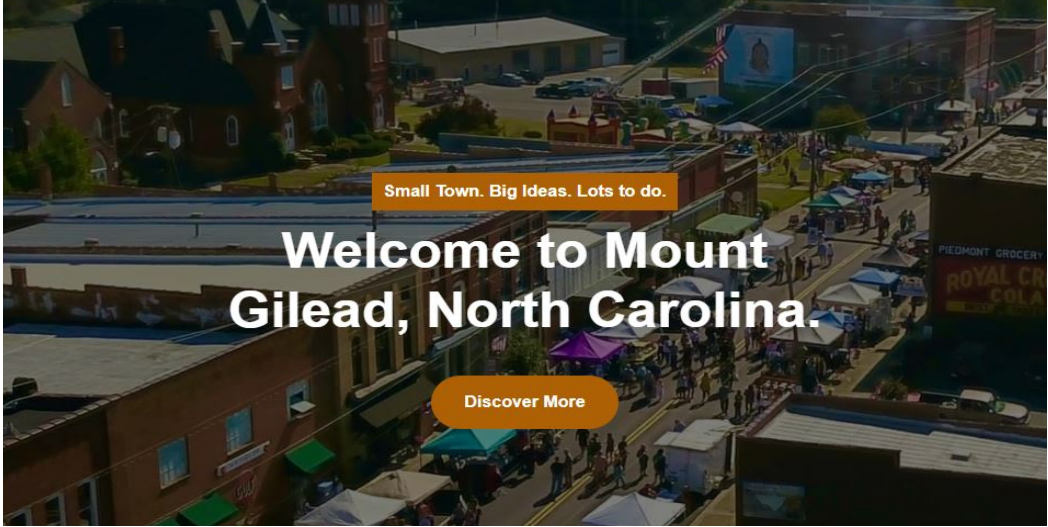
Attached in this newsletter are 3 pictures for children to color and turn back into Town Hall. These pictures will be put in the window of Town Hall for the whole Month of October!

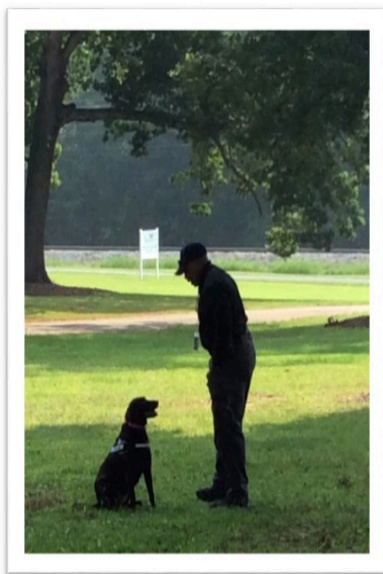

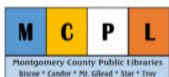

Stanback Park Pavilion Rentals



There has been a lot of questions being asked about how someone can rent out a pavilion for a day. To do that you would have to come into Town Hall located at 110 West Allenton St, Mount Gilead, NC 27306. From there you would have to fill out an application and also pay for that pavilion. Town Hall will be able to tell you what is available for the day you request. After you have your event at the pavilion you are to call the Police Department so they can check to see if things are cleaned up. If the pavilion is in good condition you will receive a refund that is 1/2 of your deposit. In city limits is 50 dollars, Outside city limits is 100 dollars.
