Rules for Public Comment

Meeting of the Town Board of Mount Gilead always include a Public Comment period. The purpose of this time is for members of the community and the general public to make their views known directly to the Town Board. To ensure a fair proceeding for all who wish to speak, please be aware of the following rules that were unanimously adopted in December 2016, that will be observed during all public meetings:

1. All persons wishing to speak shall do so from the podium to ensure an accurate record of testimony. Each person requesting to speak shall do so by signing their name, phone number on the Public Comment sign up sheet and must provide a phone number, address, and/or email address in order. No one is permitted to speak from the audience or interact and/or question the person speaking. This is a public comment session and not a public debate. Open Meetings laws for the State of North Carolina, section 197, pg. 87., and section 239, pg. 105, agree that a Mayor nor the Board of Commissioners are allowed to respond to public comment or debate with a citizen during this time. If a response is necessary, a separate meeting can be called to discuss the issue at hand or if the answer is readily available it will be answered during Department Reports by the Town Manager.
2. Each person who has signed up to speak shall have one opportunity to speak for a period not to exceed 3 minutes in duration. The speaker will not be permitted to speak again once they leave the podium, or their 3 minutes expire.
3. The Board requests that a group be represented by a spokesperson in order to keep repetitive testimony at a minimum. If this spokesperson is representing a group of more than 5 citizens, he/she is afforded the opportunity to speak for a period not to exceed 5 minutes.
4. Town staff will note all comments and provide answers directly to citizens or make information available town-wide during department reports or at the next meeting.
5. Inflammatory or immaterial testimony will not be allowed.
6. In addition to the comment period during the public meeting, individuals can provide written comments to the Town Board of Commissioners by submitting them in writing to the Town Clerk. This can be addressed by email to clerk@mtgileadnc.com or via USPS at PO Box 325, Mt. Gilead, NC 27306.

Winter is a time of rest, not just for our volunteer gardeners but for the garden itself. While the cold months may seem like a dormant period, there is plenty of activity happening beneath the surface. The soil, blanketed in straw and fallen leaves, is alive with unseen processes that prepare it for the coming spring. Mycorrhizal fungi, hidden just below the surface, work tirelessly to break down organic matter, cleaning and enriching the soil with essential nutrients. These symbiotic fungi form networks that help plants absorb nutrients more efficiently when growth resumes in warmer months.

Pollinators, so vital to our ecosystem, are also resting. Dead plant stems, fallen leaves, and mulch that many see as garden debris serve as protective habitats for bees, butterflies, and other beneficial insects. These creatures find refuge from the cold, waiting for the first signs of spring to emerge and continue their crucial work in the garden. Understanding and respecting this seasonal cycle helps us appreciate the garden as a dynamic ecosystem, not just a place for growing food and flowers.

The educational value of a winter garden is immense. It teaches patience, respect for natural processes, and the importance of allowing time for renewal. As we await the arrival of spring, we can take time to plan, reflect, and prepare for the next growing season. Thanks to generous donors like Dianna Lariviere, our community garden will be stocked with heirloom seeds from Baker Creek, ensuring a diverse and resilient crop. We are also reaching out to Burpee, who generously contributed seeds two years ago and may support our efforts again this season. Native flowers remain a priority, as they provide essential nectar and habitat for pollinators. Last summer, Tammy Privet donated a selection of native flower seeds, and these will soon be sown to give them the best possible start in our garden.

Encouraging pollinators and insect predators remains one of our key organic gardening goals. By fostering a diverse insect population, we can naturally manage pests without relying on synthetic chemicals. Winter rest is vital for that mission. While we strive to maintain organic practices, we do make an exception for fire ants, a persistent and invasive species that poses a challenge to both gardeners and beneficial insects.

Winter reminds us that rest is essential. Just as the soil, insects, and fungi pause to regenerate, so too should we take this time to recharge and prepare for the growing season ahead. When the first green shoots emerge and pollinators stir from their winter shelters, we will be ready to nurture a thriving, sustainable garden once more.
