Rules for Public Comment

Meeting of the Town Board of Mount Gilead always include a Public Comment period. The purpose of this time is for members of the community and the general public to make their views known directly to the Town Board. To ensure a fair proceeding for all who wish to speak, please be aware of the following rules that were unanimously adopted in December 2016, that will be observed during all public meetings:

1. All persons wishing to speak shall do so from the podium to ensure an accurate record of testimony. Each person requesting to speak shall do so by signing their name, phone number on the Public Comment sign up sheet and must provide a phone number, address, and/or email address in order. No one is permitted to speak from the audience or interact and/or question the person speaking. This is a public comment session and not a public debate. Open Meetings laws for the State of North Carolina, section 197, pg. 87., and section 239, pg. 105, agree that a Mayor nor the Board of Commissioners are allowed to respond to public comment or debate with a citizen during this time. If a response is necessary, a separate meeting can be called to discuss the issue at hand or if the answer is readily available it will be answered during Department Reports by the Town Manager.
2. Each person who has signed up to speak shall have one opportunity to speak for a period not to exceed 3 minutes in duration. The speaker will not be permitted to speak again once they leave the podium, or their 3 minutes expire.
3. The Board requests that a group be represented by a spokesperson in order to keep repetitive testimony at a minimum. If this spokesperson is representing a group of more than 5 citizens, he/she is afforded the opportunity to speak for a period not to exceed 5 minutes.
4. Town staff will note all comments and provide answers directly to citizens or make information available town-wide during department reports or at the next meeting.
5. Inflammatory or immaterial testimony will not be allowed.
6. In addition to the comment period during the public meeting, individuals can provide written comments to the Town Board of Commissioners by submitting them in writing to the Town Clerk. This can be addressed by email to clerk@mtgileadnc.com or via USPS at PO Box 325, Mt. Gilead, NC 27306.





The equipment is used across these sections of the department.

The town paid full and final payment of \$3750.06 for plumbing fees, without admitting wrongdoing on the town's part. **See attached.** This settlement is due because work was done by Public Works staff that led to problems with this property. I spoke with Mr. McCormick and asked him to identify the staff responsible for the mistake and give him verbal counseling and retraining.

RELEASE AGREEMENT

This Release Agreement (the "Release Agreement") is entered into this ____ day of August, 2025, (the "Effective Date"), between LEONARD MINGLE and wife, ALLISON MINGLE ("Party A"), whose address is 1205 Pineview Drive, Albemarle, North Carolina, 28001 and TOWN OF MOUNT GILEAD, a North Carolina Municipal Corporation ("Party B") with offices located at 110 West Allenton Street, PO Box 325, Mt. Gilead, North Carolina 27306. Party A and Party B are sometimes individually referred to herein as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, Party A owns a residence located at 416 Plantation Way, Mount Gilead, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Party B provides sewer service to said residence of Party A; and

WHEREAS, the sewer pump of Party A was damaged, and the plumbing contractor who replaced the sewer pump advised Party A that the damage appeared to be due to the ball valve at the sewer tap being left in an off position after maintenance or service; and

WHEREAS, Party A paid \$3,750.00 to Express Plumbing Services, Inc., for replacement of the damaged sewer pump; and

WHEREAS, Party A has requested that Party B, as the servicer of the sewer tap, reimburse Party A for the costs associated with replacement of the sewer pump; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to resolve this matter and to release each other from any and all claims that they had, have or may have arising out of or in connection with the damage to Party A's sewer pump.

1. **Consideration.** Party B agrees to pay Party A \$3,750.00 as reimbursement for the cost of Party A's replacement sewer pump, which payment shall be made on or before August 31, 2025. Other than the payment referenced in this paragraph 1, the Parties acknowledge and agree that no additional consideration of any kind is due from either Party with respect to this matter.
2. **Mutual Release.** Party A and Party B do hereby irrevocably and unconditionally release, cancel, and forever discharge the other Party and its directors, officers, employees, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, complaints, causes of action, demands, damages, obligations, liabilities, losses, promises, agreements, controversies, penalties, expenses, and executions of any kind or nature whatsoever, whether known or unknown, actual or potential, whether arising in law or in equity, which each Party may have, may have had, or may in the future obtain, arising out of or relating to any acts, omissions, agreements, or events relating in any manner to the matter described hereinabove. Furthermore, each Party represents and warrants that it has not filed any action or initiated any other proceeding with any court or government authority against or involving the other Party that may constitute a claim or provide the basis for any liability that is excluded from the release provided for in this paragraph 2.

3. **Fees and Expenses.** Each Party hereto shall bear its own fees and expenses (including attorneys' fees) incurred in connection with this matter, this Release Agreement and the consummation of the transactions contemplated hereby.
4. **Representations.** Each Party represents that the execution and delivery of this Release Agreement is the duly authorized and binding act of the Party, and that the party's signatory hereto is duly authorized to execute this Release Agreement on behalf of that Party.
5. **No Admission of Liability.** Party A and Party B expressly agree and acknowledge that their entering into this Release Agreement shall not be construed in any manner as an admission of any liability, obligation, or wrongdoing on the part of either Party. Each Party expressly denies any and all liability or wrongdoing with respect to this matter.
6. **Cooperation between the Parties.** Each Party shall fully cooperate with the other Party with respect to the performance of this Release Agreement. Each Party will provide or make available to the other Party any information and will execute, acknowledge and deliver such further documents that may reasonably be required in order to effectively perform this Release Agreement and to release all obligations and liabilities of the Parties thereunder.
7. **Governing Law and Venue.** This Release Agreement will be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of North Carolina, without giving effect to the principles of conflicts of law of such state. The Parties hereby agree that any action arising out of this Agreement will be brought solely in any state or federal court located in Montgomery County, North Carolina. Both Parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of any such court.
8. **Attorneys' Fees and Costs in Enforcement of the Release Agreement.** If either Party incurs any legal fees and/or costs and expenses in any proceeding to enforce the terms of this Release Agreement or any of its rights provided hereunder, the prevailing Party shall be entitled to recover its reasonable attorneys' fees and any court, arbitration, mediation, or other litigation expenses from the other Party.
9. **Binding Agreement.** This Release Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors, assigns and legal representatives of the Parties. There are no third party beneficiaries to this Release Agreement. Each Party acknowledges and agrees that it fully understands the provisions set forth in this Release Agreement and their effect, and that each Party is voluntarily entering into this Release Agreement.
10. **Severability.** If any provision or portion of this Release Agreement shall be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions or portions shall remain in full force and effect.
11. **Construction.** The headings and captions appearing in this Release Agreement have been inserted for the purposes of convenience and ready reference, and do not purport to and shall not be deemed to define, limit or extend the scope or intent of the provisions to which they

appertain. This Release Agreement shall not be construed more strongly against either Party regardless of which Party is more responsible for its preparation.

- 12. Counterparts.** This Release Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which will be deemed to be an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument, without necessity of production of the others. An executed signature page delivered via facsimile transmission or electronic signature shall be deemed as effective as an original executed signature page.
- 13. Notices.** All notices or other communications required under this Release Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed effective when received and made by either (i) hand delivery, (ii) registered mail, (iii) certified mail, return receipt requested, or (iv) overnight mail, addressed to the Party to be notified at said Party's address noted hereinabove.
- 14. Waiver.** No waiver of any term or right in this Release Agreement shall be effective unless in writing, signed by an authorized representative of the waiving Party. The failure of either Party to enforce any provision of this Release Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver or modification of such provision, or impairment of its right to enforce such provision or any other provision of this Release Agreement thereafter.
- 15. Entire Agreement; Modification.** This Release Agreement is the entire agreement between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes any prior agreement or communications between the Parties, whether written, oral, electronic or otherwise. No change, modification, amendment, or addition of or to this Release Agreement shall be valid unless in writing and signed by authorized representatives of the Parties. Each Party hereto has received independent legal advice regarding this Release Agreement and their respective rights and obligations set forth herein. The Parties acknowledge and agree that they are not relying upon any representations or statements made by the other Party or the other Party's employees, agents, representatives, or attorneys regarding this Release Agreement, except to the extent such representations are expressly set forth herein.
