Rules for Public Comment

Meeting of the Town Board of Mount Gilead always include a Public Comment period. The purpose of this time is for members of the community and the general public to make their views known directly to the Town Board. To ensure a fair proceeding for all who wish to speak, please be aware of the following rules that were unanimously adopted in December 2016, that will be observed during all public meetings:

1. All persons wishing to speak shall do so from the podium to ensure an accurate record of testimony. Each person requesting to speak shall do so by signing their name, phone number on the Public Comment sign up sheet and must provide a phone number, address, and/or email address in order. No one is permitted to speak from the audience or interact and/or question the person speaking. This is a public comment session and not a public debate. Open Meetings laws for the State of North Carolina, section 197, pg. 87., and section 239, pg. 105, agree that a Mayor nor the Board of Commissioners are allowed to respond to public comment or debate with a citizen during this time. If a response is necessary, a separate meeting can be called to discuss the issue at hand or if the answer is readily available it will be answered during Department Reports by the Town Manager.
2. Each person who has signed up to speak shall have one opportunity to speak for a period not to exceed 3 minutes in duration. The speaker will not be permitted to speak again once they leave the podium, or their 3 minutes expire.
3. The Board requests that a group be represented by a spokesperson in order to keep repetitive testimony at a minimum. If this spokesperson is representing a group of more than 5 citizens, he/she is afforded the opportunity to speak for a period not to exceed 5 minutes.
4. Town staff will note all comments and provide answers directly to citizens or make information available town-wide during department reports or at the next meeting.
5. Inflammatory or immaterial testimony will not be allowed.
6. In addition to the comment period during the public meeting, individuals can provide written comments to the Town Board of Commissioners by submitting them in writing to the Town Clerk. This can be addressed by email to clerk@mtgileadnc.com or via USPS at PO Box 325, Mt. Gilead, NC 27306.

Garden

❁ Gathering Garden Update ❁

Thank you to everyone who came out this month morning to help with our work day. We appreciate every volunteer who continues to support the garden. Many of our volunteers come directly from their food pantry volunteer shift and still arrive ready to work. We cleared a large amount of dead plant material for the compost pile and tidied several beds. The frost hit the garden hard this month, which is normal for the season, and we will continue tending the space through the winter as long as the weather stays cooperative.

Garden work days continue on Saturdays at 10:00 a.m. until the daylight stretches out again in the spring. We thank Monika and Mary for donating several sequoia sempervirens that will join our growing "botanical garden" style tree collection. We also thank Mary for donating another loblolly pine companion tree for the moon tree, since the original companion did not survive. The moon tree is recovering well, and the new companion has already earned the fitting name Artemis II. She will be put in the ground in a week.

Outside the gate, you will find dried okra stems and flower stems available for anyone who would like natural materials for fall or winter arrangements. Donna cut these specifically for community use, and they are free to take.

We also invite everyone to visit the corner of the garden and look at our American beautyberry bush. It is full of berries right now and supports native birds through the winter. It is an excellent native alternative to Chinese beautyberry and works well anywhere you might plant a hydrangea. The shrub provides year-round interest and supports wildlife during the hardest months. Uwharrie Native Plant private nursery carries them, and Hugh can deliver directly to your home. He founded the native plant society in our area and is a strong supporter of native gardening.

Our regular volunteers, Mary, Donna, Monika, and Darlene all worked together to put the big bed to sleep for the season. We still need more leaves, but we thank everyone who has donated so far. The leaves we have already received are helping. Winter is when we catch up in the garden, and the weeds are easier to manage. We added dead okra and frost-killed basil to the compost pile and began the long process of tidying and preparing for winter. It feels good to start gaining ground again.

We can always use more help. Through the winter we plan to hold garden work days, as long as it is not a holiday weekend or too cold, rainy, or snowy. If it is snowing, we will not be out there. Please enjoy the holiday with your family.

Thank you for your support. We appreciate every one of you and remain committed to growing a healthy and welcoming space for our community.

Town Hall Project Updates

Funding Request – \$50,000

The Town’s auditor confirmed that the General Fund is financially sound and has adequate undesignated fund balance for one-time capital improvements.

Key points from auditor’s email:

- +\$57,953.47 added to fund balance in FY ending 6/30/25
- **Total Fund Balance:** \$1,315,668.53
- **Undesignated Fund Balance:** \$490,073.53
- **Minimum Required by Statute:** \$144,844
- Auditor confirms the Town could use **up to \$300,000 safely**, though a lower amount is recommended.

Request: Staff recommends allocating **\$50,000** for Town Hall improvements (signage, cameras, interior adjustments, and related move-in costs).

6. Stanback Park Stormwater Improvements

- **Pumps:** Both pumps are on-site; activation expected after the wet well coating cures.

- **Construction scheduling:** Crew will be off the week of Christmas.
- **Next meeting: January 15 at 10:00 a.m.** (December meeting canceled due to holiday conflicts).

The "Stanback Park swale basin" is the footprint of Stanback Park itself, plus additional residential areas to the west. The park is sloped in such a way that all rainfall that falls within it eventually runs through the concrete swale located on the east side of the park. This basin is approximately 41 acres and consists almost entirely of open-space recreational areas, with very few housing structures. It is worth noting that the stormwater drains within the retention pond drainage basin, also eventually flows through the swale in the park. However, for design purposes, it was easier to delineate two separate basins.

The third basin, the "Hwy 66 Street Basin", is located south and west of Stanback Park. This area is bounded by E. 1st Street to the south and east, NC-109 to the west, and the previously discussed drainage basins to the north. This drainage basin is approximately 109 acres and contains the most impervious land cover of the three drainage basins in the proposed project area. The drainage channel that flows through the basin receives all the stormwater flow from downtown area of the Town of Mount Gilead,

The basins described above are all sub-basins within a larger basin that all converge at the same point. The receiving stream is not large enough to handle large amounts of stormwater. During large rain events, the lack of retention at the stream or the convergence point overwhelms the stream at the point of convergence and causes the banks of the stream to overflow. Once the banks overflow at the receiving stream, a spillway is created for all upstream stormwater infrastructure, which causes flooding in the project area.

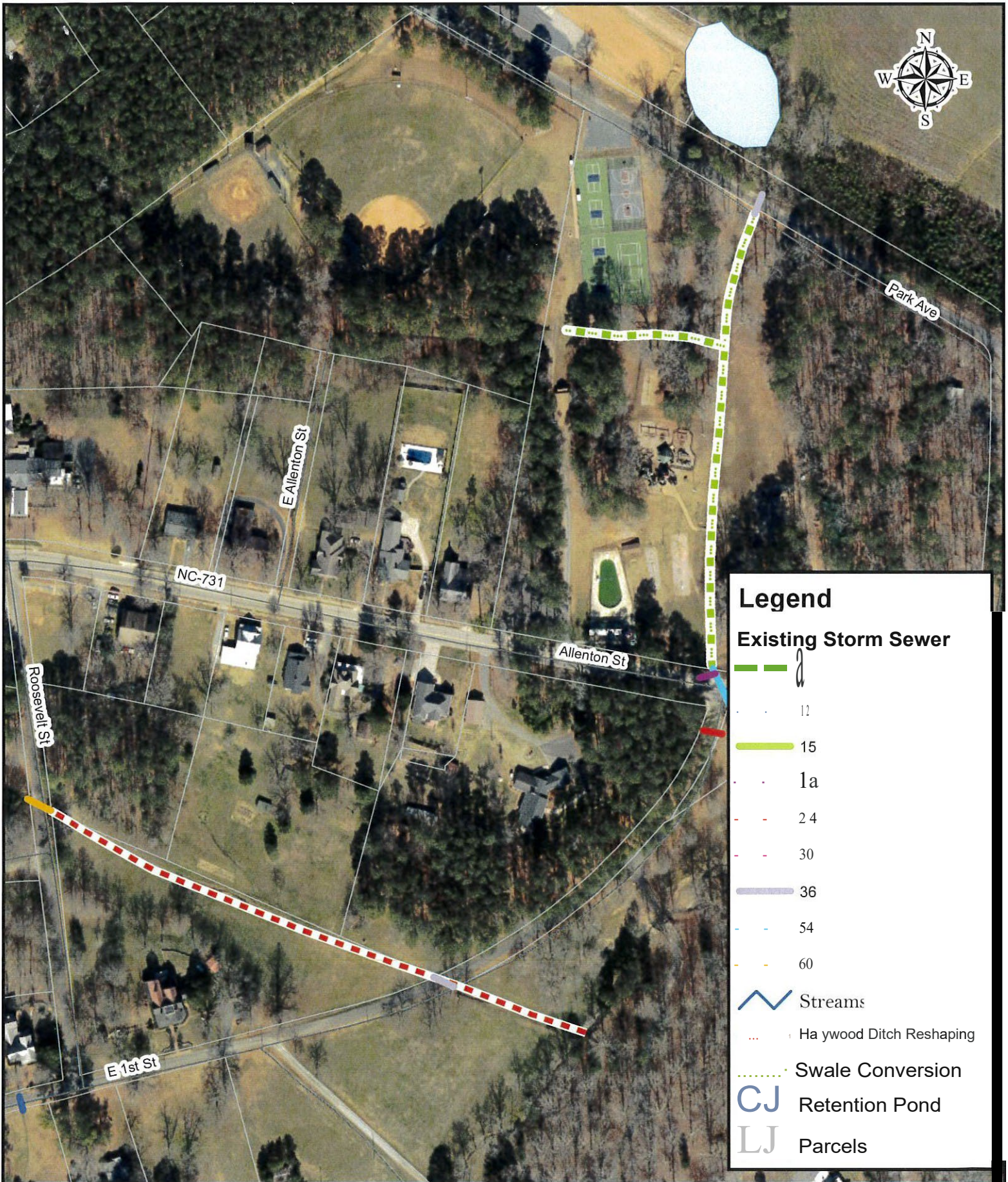

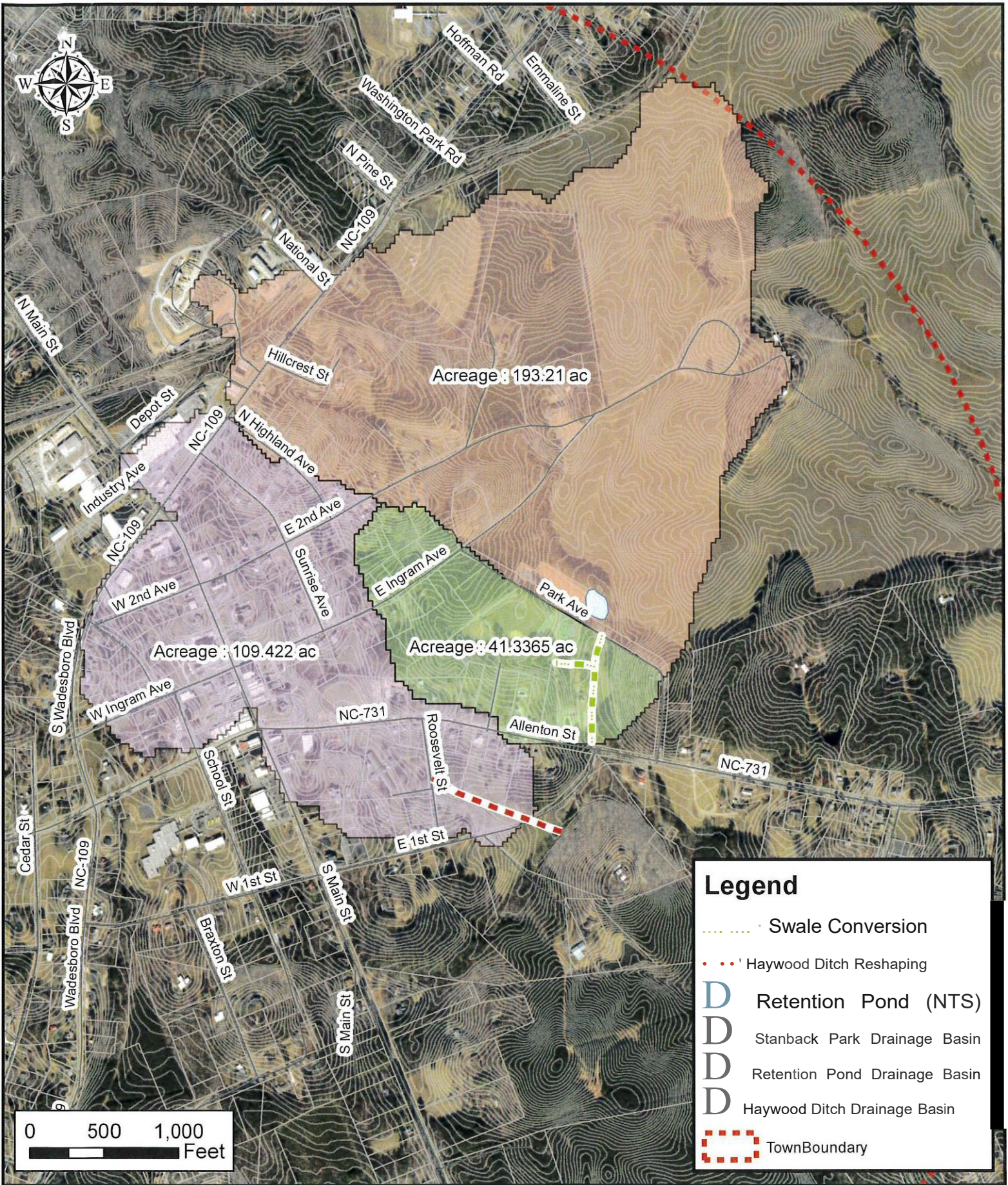

Stanback Park Stormwater Improvements

Summary for Board of Commissioners Meeting - May 7th, 2024

Applied for funding in Fall 2022 cycle, awarded in Spring 2023 for three stormwater projects:

1. Stanback Park Detention Pond - located north of Park Ave
2. Stanback Park Concrete Swale Restoration
3. E Haywood Lane Channel Reshaping

All three projects are targeted towards controlling and mitigating flood conditions in these areas.

LL&C has completed site survey and provided info to McAdams Co for use in preliminary design in support of the Engineering Report (ER) submittal due to NCDEQ-DWI (funding agency) on May 31st, 2024.

Stanback Park Detention Pond

Our environmental subconsultant - Natural Resources Consultant (NRC) determined the stream north of Park Ave to be jurisdictional, which means stream channel and low flow conditions must be maintained so as to promote aquatic passage and avoid impacts to local wildlife.

Jurisdictional status thus limits our design in that we can no longer consider a retention pond that creates an impoundment against Park Ave. An off-channel storage was also considered however, it would introduce levees on the stream banks which will disconnect the stream from its floodplain and impact the waterway. Storage area can be achieved by manipulating the existing topography and create a wider floodplain at a minimal slope to manage stormwater flows to/through Stanback park.

Stanback Park Concrete Swale

Plan is to restore the channel to a more natural condition with low grass and sparse trees/bushes planted to maintain the more open park feel. Channel will have two tiers one for low flow and one to hold the 2-yr storm without overtopping banks.

E Haywood Lane Channel

Modifications to existing channel to manage flooding, survey of stream and existing utilities showed that the existing sanitary sewer is in very close proximity to the channel and is a limiting factor to the stream reshaping. We are able to grade a wider floodplain on the south side of the channel which will reduce flooding impact through this area.

Next steps following submittal and review of the Engineering Report include a design submittal of October 31st, 2024 for NCDEQ Review/Approval. Permitting of the proposed project will take place concurrently with design and review. Once the bid documents are approved, we would likely bid the project in December 2024 / January 2025.
